### Volunteer with Bethesda Lutheran Communities

### "On the contrary, those parts of the body that seem to weaker are indispensable" 1 Corinthians 12:22

What if I told you that there is a group of people that we the church tend to miss? There are people in your church now who may visually appear to be weaker-people with disabilities-and yet God tells us that we need them. They are indispensable. We are indispensable in the body of Christ.

Bethesda Lutheran Communities is a Christian organization whose mission is to enhance the lives of people with disabilities through services that share the good news of Jesus Christ. As a Ministry Consultant with Bethesda, I have the privilege of supporting the faith lives of over 100 adults with disabilities who live in 15 different homes in neighborhoods in Cypress, Tomball, and Spring. In fact, many of you have had the opportunity to visit one of our group homes to deliver flower planters, prepare and share a meal together, and lead a Bible study or time of worship.

God is inviting you to include, welcome, and build relationships with people we support and people with disabilities so that they may know Jesus and share His love with all people!

We need people to come and pray with the people we support and staff Monday-Friday during business hours and in the homes on weekday evenings and weekends.

### Include people with disabilities in the existing life of your church:

Host and invite the people we support and staff to a Bible Study at St. Timothy

Sit with people we support during worship

Come alongside and include them in existing Sunday school classes

Include and serve alongside the people we support and staff at church wide community service projects (Spring Carnival, Trunk-or-Treat, etc.).

**Bridge the Gap:** Bethesda Texas operates at a 2.4-million-dollar loss each year. Texas is a zero-reimbursement state for Intellectual and Developmental disability services. 
