St. Timothy Lutheran Church 45th Anniversary Church Picnic Sunday, September 16th

It was over 45 years ago that St. Timothy was birthed as a new mission church. Property was purchased by the Texas District for the new Church and congregation on FM 149 at Schroeder Road now called FM 249. A special Groundbreaking service took place on Sunday, February 18, 1973. St. Timothy Lutheran Church was officially chartered as a congregation on Sunday, September 16, 1973.



The name of the congregation was chosen by the prospective

members of the Church which at that time was called "THE FM 149 LUTHERAN CHURCH." A list of 33 names were submitted and ballots were taken, the name "ST. TIMOTHY" was selected as the name of the new mission in northwest Harris County. (Pastor Simcak is shown above at the groundbreaking ceremony. The first church on HWY. 149 shown left.)

Paul's wrote these two letters to the believers in Thessalonica to encourage them in their walk of faith, help them face challenges in their world, instruct them in Godly living, and prepare for Christ's second coming. God's Word applies as much in today's world as it did then, and this section of God's Word will strengthen you in your understanding of how God is calling us to live as His chosen people. Led by Pastors Steve and Brad in Room 201.

The Circle Maker

Mark Batterson, in his book The Circle Maker, delves into the idea that "drawing circles around our dreams" can become "a mechanism whereby God accomplishes great things in us." We will examine prayer and how we can focus our prayer life. drawing prayer circles around dreams, family and the promises of God, trusting in His Word and character to accomplish His greater purpose. Led by Jeff Barckholtz in 202. Jeff and his wife Katie are diligent in teaching their 2 young children the truth of God's Word. Jeff was blessed to have been raised in a home where Jesus was lifted up in word and lifestyle, and he continues to share the Good News with his high school students and anyone else he meets.

Who Were the Prophets?

The word translated prophet from Hebrew means 'who speaks for God'. Over the nearly 4,000 years from creation until Jesus came God selected many individuals to "speak for Him". Who were these men and women and how and why did God select them? Come and hear their story and see how their lives and the lives of those around them were impacted by their acceptance of God's call. Led by John Rohan in 101. John has been a trusted teacher of God's truth for many years, bringing insight into scripture that strengthens a Biblical perspective. He includes information about recent discoveries that support events recorded in scripture. He and his wife are devoted to helping others discover the joy of following Jesus.

Where Do I Fit in God's Plans?

You are not an accident but have a purpose. God has a plan for you and you have been specifically designed with gifts and talents that God is expecting you to utilize - not alone but as part of a team. As a part of the "body of Christ," you have a spot on the team and are needed for Kingdom work. Led by Jeff Sjurseth in 102/103. Jeff and his wife, Leslie, have long called St Timothy their church home, whether living in Houston or somewhere else in the world on overseas work assignments. Jeff is a Biblical scholar, delving deeply into God's Word and things that matter for eternity. His thoughtful analysis will encourage you in your life as a disciple of Christ.

Women Only Class - Walking by Faith

Do you walk by faith or by sight? This video study is taught by Jennifer Rothschild who has been blind since age 15. She contrasts the evidences of walking by faith and walking by sight, teaching how to release control to God, persevere through hardships, and fully receive God's gifts when we are guided by the truth rather than our feelings. Discussion led by Janis Heider and Shelly Meyer in 202. Janis and Shelly, friends for many years, will co-lead the follow up conversation to the video. Shelly is very familiar with learning how to walk in the darkness as she, too, has the same eve disease as the author.
