
The cups in the center of the Communion tray contain grape juice for those who wish to avoid alcohol.

If you agree with the statements below, you are welcome to attend communion. Children may be brought to communion for a blessing.




- 1. I believe that Jesus Christ is God's Son and my personal Savior, and I am baptized.
