On October 31st, 1517 Martin Luther, an Augustinian monk and Professor of theology at Wittenberg, Germany posted ninety-five statements for debate on the door of the castle church and the protestant reformation was born. These statements, or theses were a challenge to fellow theologians and students to try to harmonize several practices of the Roman Catholic church with the truth of scripture. Luther was convinced that the authority for all teachings and practices of the church was the

scripture. Luther was convinced that the authority for all teachings and practices of the church was the Bible and not the hierarchy of the Church. His ninety-five theses were quickly picked-up and by using the latest technology of his day, the printing press, were distributed throughout Europe and the process of reform was begun. **Grace Alone**; Faith Alone; and Scripture Alone. 




Rewired For Christ: Meets October 17th, 10 AM in Room 101




