This helps us adequately plan for our summer needs.

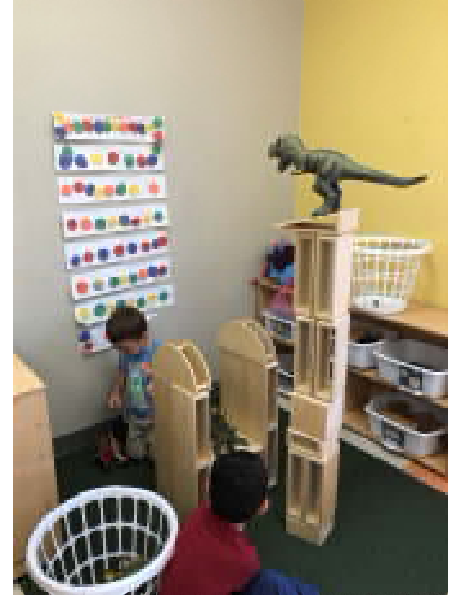


## Spring Carnival
