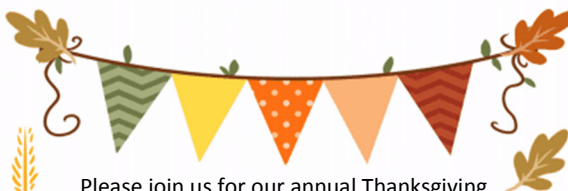


On November 27th we will not have Pit Stop. Instead, join us for Thanksgiving Eve service at 7:00 p.m.
