Ephesians 3:17-18 says, "And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ." He takes us Deeper in our relationship with Him and others as we dig into the Word of God and build relationships that are rooted in Christ.
