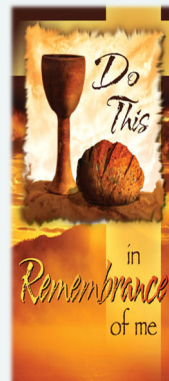
HOLY COMMUNION
