**Movie and Pajama Day**

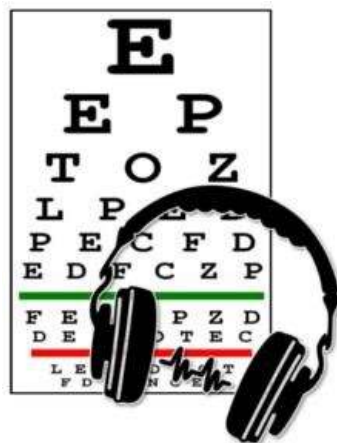
