## Reminders!

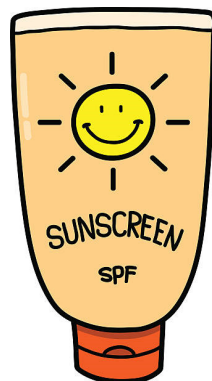
