Spring Book Fair is happening now! Stop by and take a look. There are also wish lists of books that teachers would like for their classrooms if you are interested in supporting our school in this way.

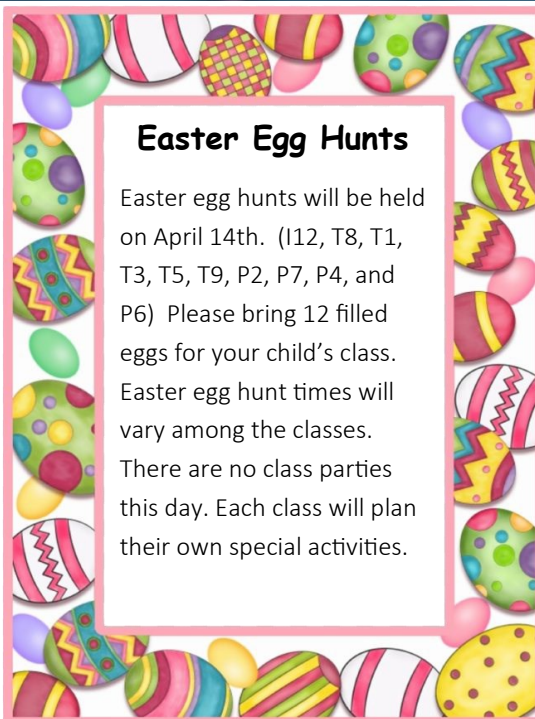

Easter Egg Hunts

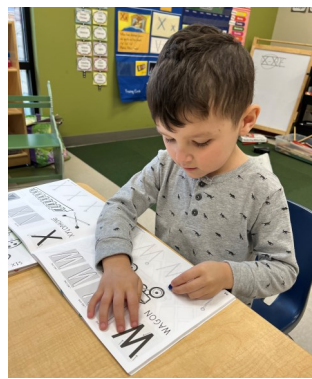
