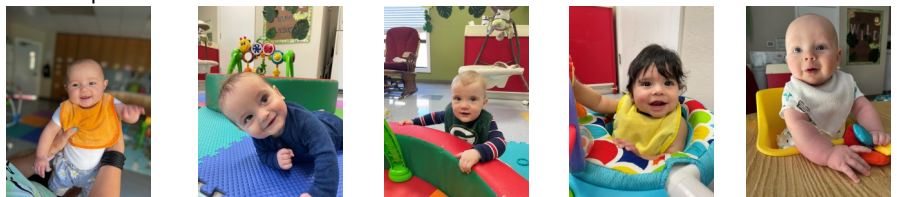
**Picture Day**
