If you haven't already, please send in labeled containers of sunscreen and bug spray. We are only able to use what you provide for your child.



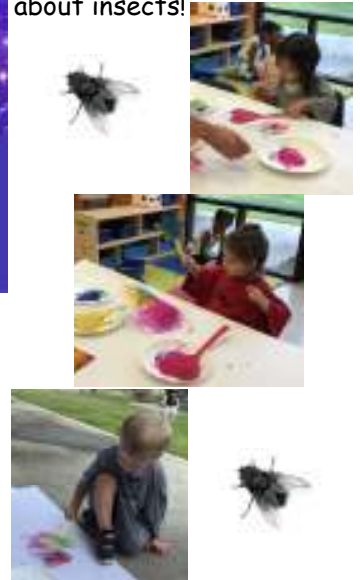
Closing Program
