What do we learn in the Dramatic Play center?

In our dramatic play centers children are encouraged to pretend and act out different roles. This pretend play teaches our students self regulation, self help skills (putting on and taking off costumes), builds language, and encourages conflict resolution. Throughout the year you may notice that the dramatic play center changes along with the theme in your child's classroom, allowing the children to explore new language around the theme. This also supports literacy skills as new print materials are brought in and children explore different needs for writing such as taking a person's order at a restaurant.

Afterwards, the children will return to their classrooms for more festivities!

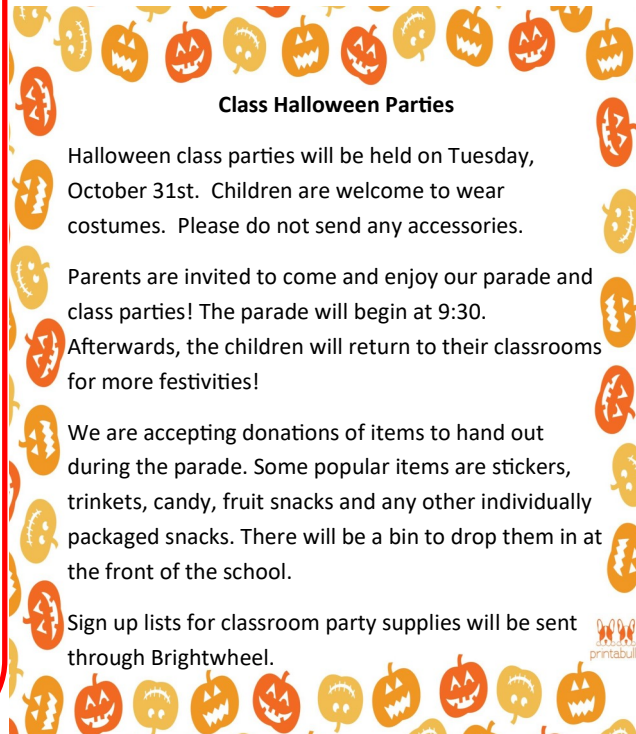
