P6 Spotlight



What an incredible journey we've had so far this year in P6! Our Pre-K class has made remarkable strides in building our emerging literacy and writing skills, including letter identification, understanding phonemes and other phonemic awareness skills, writing our names and other letters and numbers, and comprehension skills. We have also been exploring mathematical concepts such as measuring weight, length, height, and volume with different tools, graphing, counting, adding and subtracting, completing and creating patterns, and more. In the world of science, our curiosity has led us to explore fun and fascinating questions such as "Why does it rain?", "What happens when we combine baking soda and vinegar with candy canes?", "How does milk react to dish soap?", and "How do the ingredients change as we add, mix, and bake them to make muffins?", as well as numerous STEAM activities. We practice and further develop our language, self-help, social, problem-solving, literacy, and mathematical skills in the dramatic play center, trying our hands at being paleontologists, doctors, librarians, hair stylists, bakers, astronauts, and families, among others. It's amazing to look back to the beginning of the school year and realize how much progress we have made. It is exciting to witness the great strides we have made in our language development, social skills, independence, cognitive development, and preparedness for Kindergarten. I love to watch the children grow and learn and am excited to continue to find new and engaging ways to teach them for the remainder of the year!
