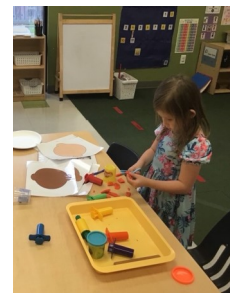
Whether you are new to Bright Beginners or have been with us in previous years, we are so thankful to have you with us this school year! Below are a few reminders to get us off to a great start.
