## Preparing for Kindergarten

All the work that your children do in preschool is preparing them to be successful in their next step – Kindergarten! In their early preschool years, they are “learning how to learn” by following routines, problem solving with peers and following directions. They gain independence and begin to focus on tasks for extended time periods. We begin to introduce them to more academic curriculum as they progress through their years at Bright Beginners Preschool. Students learn literacy, phonics and writing through our Get Set for School Curriculum. The foundations of early math skills are solidified through the Everyday Mathematics Curriculum. This curriculum includes hands on lessons in number and shape recognition, patterns, counting, operations, graphing and spatial relations. Many of our students begin working on Kindergarten level curriculum after meeting the Prekindergarten expectations. Our students graduate from our program fully prepared for the coming expectations and challenges of the next school year.
